- The purpose of this group was reviewed per the request of the CofC. All subcommittees have been asked to review their purpose.

Data Review: - MaryAnn Priester:

- Reviewed Q2 data – 24% of referrals for CE get a completed CE/ 193 callers called more than 1 time
- 246 singles called
- 86 families called
- LOT from 211 – CE is 6 days (this is down from 8 days in Q1)
- Once someone calls CE hotline (must leave a voicemail) CE staff make 1 attempt to return the voicemail or text. They will continue to reach back to caller if the caller returns calls/texts.
- 247 households had a shelter entry
- 309 callers were at risk of homelessness and 12 were referred to the Prevention Navigator.
- Complaints about CE or the process can be referred to Megan.
