Meeting Minutes

- Welcome and Introductions
- Review of Data –
 - Through May 2022, increased to 386 (1266) families. This includes adults with children and couples.
 - 317 people were new in May 243 new to system, 57 return from housing, 17 return from inactive
 - 137 families were included in outflow – housed, exited system
 - Our outflow is decreasing – causing a great increase in homelessness data.
 - 112 people housed
 - There was no clear indicator that helped understand the large increase. Rents are increasing, pricing families out of renewals, which possibly begins their journey to homelessness.

 - What's working?
 - Ways to improve
- 6 Month Check In
 - Resetting Goals and Priorities
 - There has been an increase in family homeless since beginning
 - Needs for increase in voucher amount.
 - Inlivan has suggested that rent reasonableness be submitted for their review.
 - Stronger emphasis on employment. Salvation Army is having a job fair with Novant.
 - Follow up for next time:
 - Deronda will meet with shelter residents to learn more about barriers to employment
 - Alicia will share information regarding training programs.
 - Karen will learn more about ways to access childcare subsidies during job search and recruitment process.
