The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Continuum of Care (CoC) is charged by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to submit a community-wide application for homeless assistance funds.

This announcement serves as the opportunity for agencies to submit a Letter of Interest (LOI) form to express their interest in submitting new, expansion and/or renewal projects as part of the HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Homeless Assistance Grants competition.

Agencies considering submitting a Letter of Interest form must be able to clearly demonstrate their ability to successfully meet CoC program outcomes in one or more of the activity areas as outlined in the Homeless Emergency Assistance and Rapid Transition to Housing: Continuum of Care Program; Interim Final Rule (24 CFR Part 578; Docket No. FR-5476-I-01).

*The priority for funding made available through reallocation and/or HUD CoC Bonus will be Permanent Supportive Housing projects and PSH or RRH projects with coordination between a housing provider & a healthcare provider and PSH or RRH projects that provide housing for those experiencing unsheltered homelessness.

Note: Projects must be ready to begin in calendar year 2023.

Funding for these projects is provided through the HUD COC Homeless Assistance Grant Programs (under the HEARTH Act.) Submission of a Letter of Interest does not constitute an application, nor does it constitute approval for funding by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg CoC or by HUD.

CoC Projects are designed to:

• Promote community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness.

- Fund efforts by nonprofit providers and State and local governments to quickly house or rehouse homeless individuals and families while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused to homeless individuals, families, and communities by homelessness.
- Promote access to and utilization of mainstream benefits by homeless individuals.
- Provide supportive services that are voluntary, flexible and consumer driven.
